Dr. Nissi Hamilton is the founder and director of Nissi's Network which works for juvenile justice and human trafficking prevention. She is the recipient of the National Black Prosecutors Association Profiles in Courage Award, The Paul H. Chapman Foundation for the Improvement of Justice Award, New Friends New Life Protect Her Award, and she is a two-time Presidential Lifetime Achievement Award recipient for her work in the community. Rescued from her trafficker by joining the US Navy, she is a Navy Veteran who earned her bachelor's degree in criminal justice with a minor in technical management, MBA in accounting and MBA in human resource management. She also holds an Honorary Doctorate in Global Humanitarianism for her human trafficking advocacy in Uganda, Africa for children who are suffering with HIV and in Pakistan for widowed mothers who are forced to marry their daughters as young as 12 to older men for money. Dr. Hamilton is married to Executive Chef Kenneth Hamilton, and they have 8 children.
