## You Could Mean Freedom

### Recognize Indicators

Some of the potential indicators of TIP are:\*

Physical/Environmental indicators of victims:

- Signs of physical abuse (e.g. bruises, cuts, burns, broken bones)
- Have no identification
- Live at or be confined to worksite
- Be escorted or closely monitored at all times

Psychological/Behavioral indicators of victims:

- Fearful
- Submissive
- Anxious
- Nervous

*\*Indicators listed are not absolute signs of TIP, but when demonstrated together are good indicators.*
