



Combating Trafficking in Persons Child Sexual Exploitation

100 million reports of suspected child sexual exploitation to NCMEC CyberTipline since 1998

21.7 million CyberTipline reports on children being sexually abused in 2020 alone

17,000 reports of possible child sex trafficking from all 50 states, Washington, D.C. and Puerto Rico

97.5% increase in online enticement reports compared to 2019

• 37,872 in 2020 and 19,174 in 2019



Military connected students in U.S. and abroad now have a specialized **Student Guide to Preventing Human Trafficking**, created by DoD CTIP in partnership with JKO

Between October 2013 and April 2016, there were **1,428** reports of sextortion of minors made to NCMEC's CyberTipline

• The ages of child victims ranged from 8 - 17 years old

"Sextortion" is a new online exploitation crime directed towards children in which non-physical forms of coercion are used, such as blackmail, to acquire sexual content from the child, engage in sex with the child, or obtain money from the child.
